The Sunset Blvd 414ce Studio delivers a high-performance playing experience with premium tonewoods and refined aesthetics. This cutaway Grand Auditorium model pairs solid Indian rosewood back and sides with a torrefied Sitka spruce top, delivering a rich, articulate voice with enhanced warmth and responsiveness thanks to Taylor's V-Class bracing. The torrefied soundboard provides a more seasoned, played-in tone from the start, while the rosewood's lush low-end and sparkling top-end clarity make this guitar incredibly versatile. Visually, the guitar features a full-gloss body finish with a stunning Sunset Edgeburst top, chamfered body edges, a three-ring rosette with black and white purfling, Italian acrylic diamond inlays, and gold Taylor tuning machines. It comes equipped with Taylor's ES2 electronics and includes a structured tan gig bag with backpack straps for easy transport.

Sunset Blvd 214ce DLX

This Sunset Blvd-exclusive 200 Deluxe Series model blends layered Indian rosewood back and sides with a solid torrefied Sitka spruce top for rich tone and striking visual character. Taylor's Cantilevered V-Class bracing enhances projection and sustain, while the Grand Auditorium body shape delivers versatility across styles. A
