

GRAMMY AWARD-WINNING PRODUCER DON WAS NAMES LANITA SMITH WINNER OF GUITAR CENTER'S FOURTH ANNUAL SINGER-SONGWRITER PROGRAM

As the winner, Smith will receive a career-boosting package including the opportunity to record a four-song EP with Grammy Award-winning producer Don Was, mentorship from Grammy Award-winning singer-songwriter Colbie Caillat, a performance on <u>Jimmy Kimmel Live!</u>, \$25,000 cash, new musical equipment, and more.

Out of nearly 16,000 entries this year, five finalists were chosen to perform live at the finals Friday, March 6th at The Troubadour in Los Angeles, CA, hosted by established singer-songwriter Clara C. Following an opening performance by previous *Guitar Center Singer-Songwriter* winners Josh Doyle, Jeff Campbell and Tess Henley, each of the finalists took to the stage to perform live in front of the audience and judges. Colbie Caillat treated the crowd to a special live set as program judge Don Was deliberated, and ultimately, named Smith the winner.
